OHP has two benefit packages, PLUS and STANDARD.

The PLUS package replaces the basic benefit package and is for individuals who are: pregnant; under age 19; blind, disabled or age 65+ and receiving SSI or waived services; or those receiving medical benefits through Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF).

The STANDARD package is new and has fewer services and will require co-payments and mandatory premiums. Individuals who do not meet the requirements for the PLUS package may still be eligible for the STANDARD package.

## Who Are We?

The Medicaid Unit Operates under Health Department Objective 2.1 A: Assure 100% access to needed health care.

Our Mission is to assist our community to participate in the Oregon Health Plan, as well as provide access to other available health and human services.

The Medicaid Enrollment is a unit of the Multnomah County Health Department. We operate under contract from the State of Oregon to provide outreach and enrollment for the Oregon Health Plan and other health and human services.



## What Do We Do?

Eligibility Specialists screen uninsured / under-insured individuals for the Oregon Health Plan and related health programs and assist applicants/clients in:


- Completing application forms;
- Choosing medical and dental plans;
- Explaining OHP benefits;
- Following up with application status at the State;
- Advocating for clients needs;
- Assisting in reapplication process every 6 months.
- The staff also works closely with Portland Public Schools and with the Multnomah Education Service District to reach uninsured children and families.
